Significant work experience in Peace and Conflict Related areas.

**Desirable:**

Education at undergraduate/post graduate level in Peace and conflict related studies.

We will prioritise applications from applicants who have not attended previous INCORE Summer Schools but those who have already attended are also welcome to apply. Successful applicants are expected to be present for the entire course.

Accommodation is provided for six nights from Sunday 6 June until Friday 11 June (inclusive). Participants will be staying in an ensuite room in self-catering apartments with a shared kitchen and dining area. The apartments are situated in the University of Ulster Student Village, Duncreggan.
